#### **I. Context:**

Established in 1951, IOM is a Related Organization of the United Nations, and as the leading UN agency in the field of migration, works closely with governmental, intergovernmental and non-governmental partners. IOM is dedicated to promoting humane and orderly migration for the benefit of all. It does so by providing services and advice to governments and migrants.

In Morocco, IOM implements projects of assistance to vulnerable migrants, strengthening the link between migration and development and assistance to marginalized youth with a view to preventing irregular migration from Morocco.

As part of the axis "assistance to migrants," IOM, with the support of the Finnish government, is implementing a regional project to support governments in managing migration by turning the emphasis on promoting health and wellbeing amongst migrants in transit in Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia and Yemen. In each of these target countries under the mentioned project, IOM has been implementing a variety of activities to help migrants with health needs, namely:

- (1) direct humanitarian and medical assistance to migrants;
- (2) assistance to national authorities to better manage health needs of migrants;
- (3) capacity building of government and non-government health facilities to improve health care services;
- (4) sharing information on available health care and other issues of interest to migrants with health needs;
- (5) support to the government and civil society stakeholders to help the most vulnerable migrants (victims of trafficking, single mothers, unaccompanied minors, among others).

#### **II. Core Functions / Responsibilities**

Under the overall supervision of the Chief of Mission, the programme manager and the direct supervision of the Migration Health Coordinator at the IOM office in Rabat, Morocco, the Consultant will provide technical and administrative support to the Migration Health Coordination as well as support to the preparations for the:

1. Academic forum linked with the ongoing Migration health country profile mapping in Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, Libya and Yemen
2. International Symposium on Migration and Health
3. Extended project steering committee workshop

- Help analyze and share related thematic information (including issues, trends and data) as well as good practices with country missions, relevant colleagues and external parties.

- Experience in public health related research and M&E methods, data analysis or report writing/editing.
- Experience in volunteer assignment, internship or consultancy in international organizations as well as familiarity on migration health issues especially epidemiology an asset.
- Experience in preparations for large-scale and high-level conference (involving multi countries, regions) as an asset as well.
- Thorough knowledge English. Working knowledge of French. knowledge of Arabic is advantageous.
